◆ HEC MSc in Management Program 2030 students:

- First-year students (short internships, 2-4 months)
- Second-year students (long internships, 2-12 months)
- Third-year students (end-of-studies internships until September, pre-job internships, full employment)

◆ MSc: 81 students

- A twelve-month program open to non-French speakers who hold a bachelor degree in business and who want to acquire an expertise in a specific field of management
- MSc in International Business (MIB), MSc in Finance (MIF), MSc in Managerial & Financial Economics (MMFE), MSc in Sustainable Development (MISD), MSc in Marketing (MMKG).

Students are looking for internships from 4 to 6 months, between June and December, and jobs.

◆ HEC Specialized Masters - 402 graduates per year in 12 programs:

Audit, Business Law and International Management (in partnership with ESCP-Europe), Entrepreneurship, International Finance, Marketing Intelligence, Management of Large Projects (in partnership with ISAE), Management of Sustainable Development, Supply Chain Management, International Risks Management, Management of Information Systems (in partnership with the MINES ParisTech), Net-business, Strategic Management.

Students are looking for end-of-studies internships between May and December and full-time employment.

◆ HEC MBA program - 523 participants:

A part-time or full-time 16-month, English or bilingual program representing 47 nationalities (85% non-French).

HEC MBA program ranking:

- 1st in France and 5th in Europe by The Economist Intelligence Unit
- 9th outside the United States, 6th in Europe and 2nd in France by Business Week.

◆ HEC Ph.D. Program - 82 Students: 43% non-French doctoral students.

HEC Paris is mainly:

- 30% of HEC Grande Ecole, 11% of HEC Specialized Masters and 70% of the MBA program graduates begin their career outside of France.
- Part of a global student exchange network with 137 premier universities and business schools.

◆ An international perspective

- 95 nationalities are represented on the campus. An average GMAT score of 720 for foreign students admitted into the 2nd year of HEC MSc in Management program participants and of 690 for MBA participants. HEC Grande Ecole students must spend 20 weeks abroad as part of an academic and/or working experience before graduation.

◆ HEC Paris, a member of the "Conférence des Grandes Ecoles" and of the "Chapitre des Ecoles de Management", is the first french school to hold the prestigious triple crown accreditation from:

- the European accreditation EQUIS by EFMD (European Foundation for Management Development)
